Cowboy Poetry is an interactive equine assisted learning program aligned to the Michigan English/Language Arts Content Expectations. Through carefully designed curriculum and hands-on activities, Cowboy Poetry promotes the underlying skills necessary for complex language development often difficult to teach in the traditional classroom setting. No prior horse experience necessary.

Classes begin September 16 and run for 6 weeks on Wednesday evenings from 6:00-7:30pm. Cost is \$300. Register before September 6 and receive a 10% early registration discount (\$270). Class size is limited to 10. Classes will be held in Baroda, Michigan.
